They have also been learning about the importance of the concept of giving and kindness:

Charity

1. Zakah is the giving of alms (Charity) to those in need.
2. The people must pay 2.5% of their money.
3. Nisab means you don't need to pay Zakah.
4. It's a threshold. If you earn more than the nisab you pay Zakah. If you earn less you don't pay.
5. Two groups that may receive Zakah are those whose heart need winning over and to free slaves.
5. Muslims pay Zakah because its to give money to charity and to help people survive.
