Challenge: can you find out the difference between the prices?

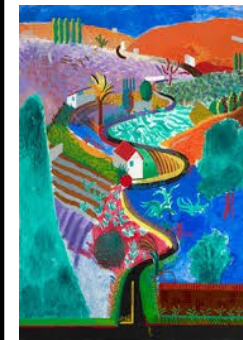
History
