I see this as another opportunity for the partnership between our school and parents to support our pupils in a sensitive but highly important area of the curriculum.

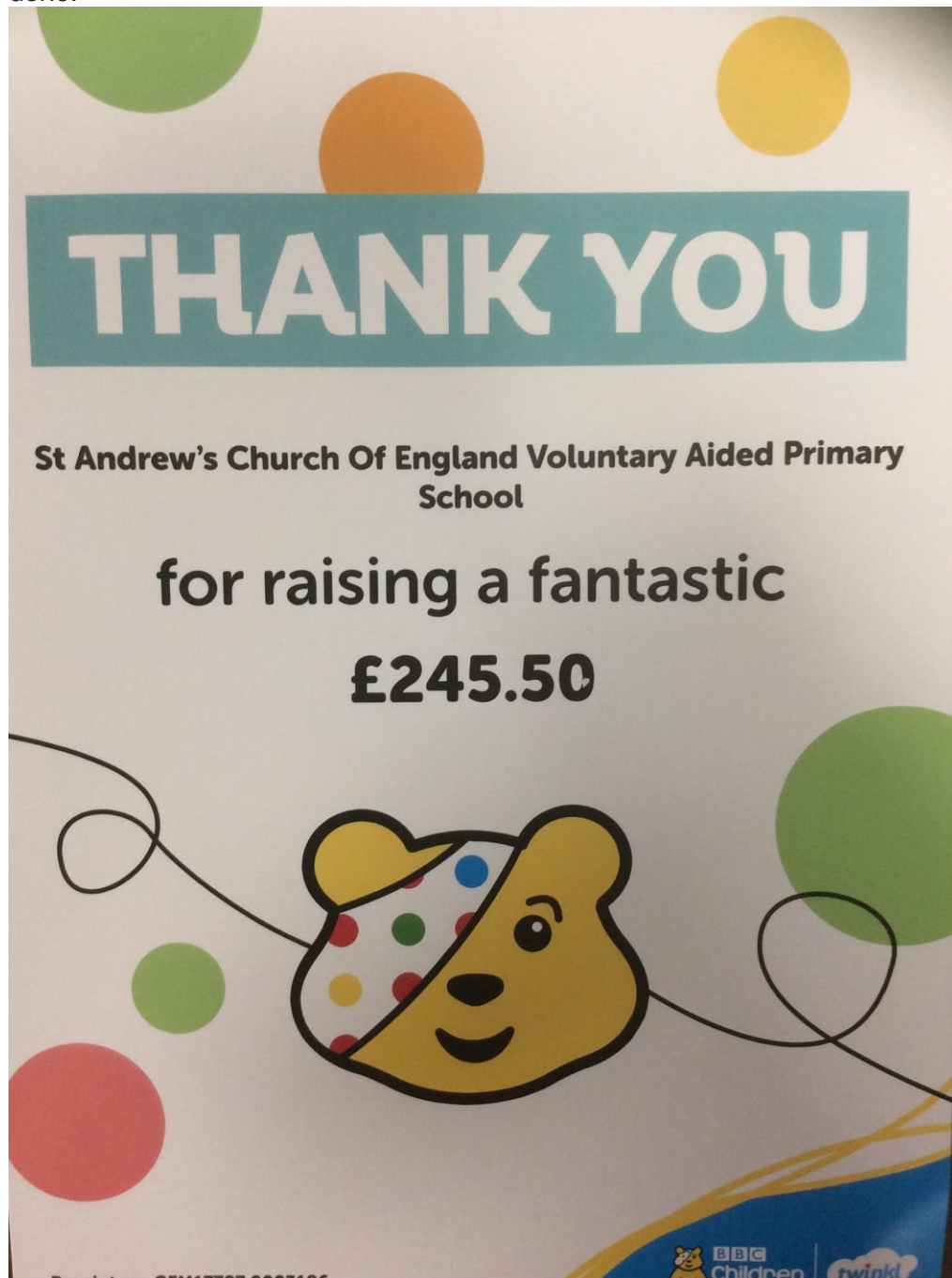
