1. Preparation for September...our arrangements for transition are starting much earlier this year.....commencing this week with news of which teachers will be having our new Y6 classes in September.

It is hoped all children will find out the names of their class teachers for September over the next few weeks. These announcements are 2 months earlier than usual as we plan for continued development of Basic Skills progress in the Non Negotiables in Reading, Writing, Grammar and Number work. - Next year is likely to see the return of National Testing (SAT's) in Y2 and Y6 as well as Phonic testing (Y1) and Times Table National Tests in Y4. The preparation for these 'tests' is never left just for the Year Group in which they have their test but starts in previous Year Groups- hence the importance of continually developing those important Basic Skills - at home as well as at school.

We aim to be ready by building on all the good work parents have helped with at home during this Covid period. Thank you. Let's hope our children really benefit from the great efforts of parents, staff and the kiddies themselves during the various Lockdowns.

2. Reminder - Awareness raising – Tomorrow (Thursday 6th May) is 'Wishbone Day'...Kids may wear something yellow with their uniform- if they wish- to help raise awareness of the disability **Osteogenesis Imperfecta**. This Charity uses yellow as a symbol of a promising future.
