## Every Child A Champion In Their Own Right Matthew 5.16 – 'Let Your Light So Shine'

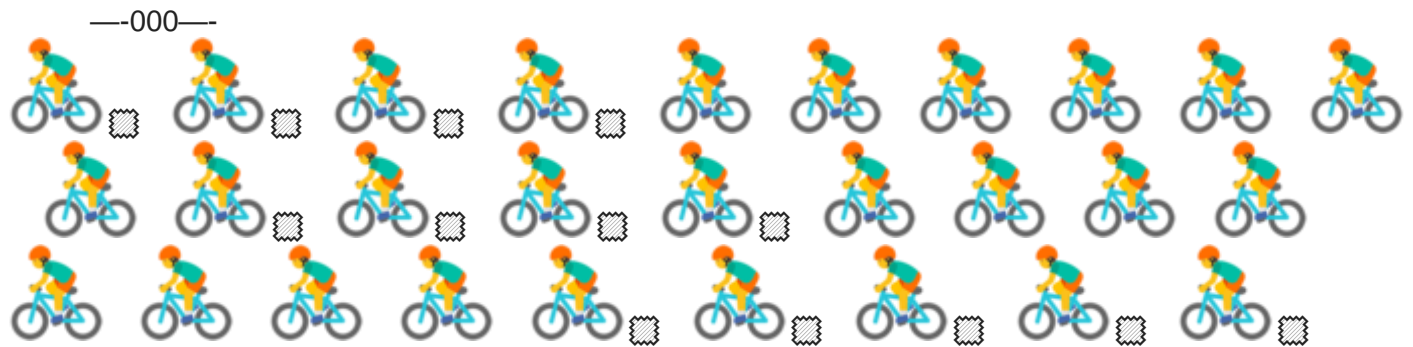
Hi Parents....

The Y5 Raywell class for Friday - can bring their cuddly to Raywell as we will be having our usual picnic lunch.



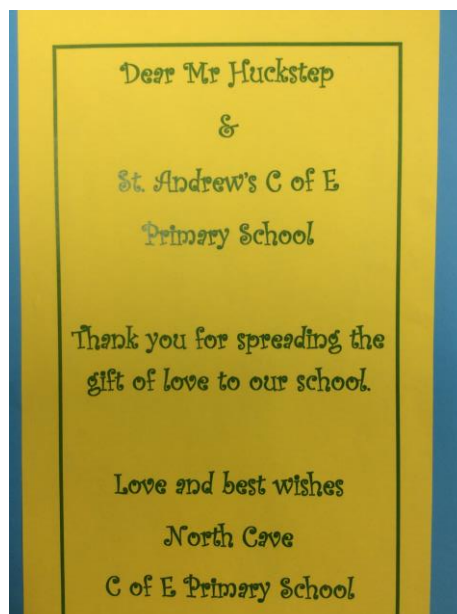
The next part of our mega Charity Bike Challenge is almost upon us - See timetable + arrangements after the photos:-

  - At the end of the day, children will collect their bikes etc and wait at normal time to be collected. Parents are asked to follow normal exit procedure ... please guard against any congestion. Thank You.
  - Any child found to have an unsafe bike will not be allowed to ride their bike but can still join in by walking or running their way around.
