March 2023

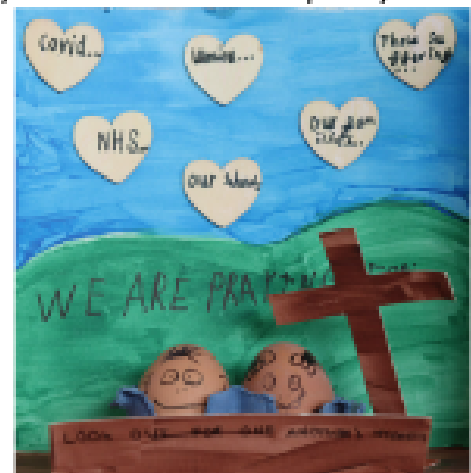
