
INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT
VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOLS

1. The name of the school is: **St Andrew's Voluntary Aided Church of England Primary School**
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is: **The Governing Body of St Andrew's Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. *three* parent governors
 - b. The headteacher (ex officio)
 - c. *one* staff governor
 - d. *one* local authority governor
 - e. *eight* foundation governors
5. Total number of governors: *Fourteen*
6. Foundation governors are appointed by the York Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with the Parochial Church Council of the Parish in which the school is situated.
7.
 - a. The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio: The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish in which the school is situated.
 - b. The Archdeacon of the East Riding shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which his governorship exists.
8. The Archdeacon of the East Riding shall have the right to request the removal of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named above.
9. The school does not have a Trust Deed.

10. "Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils."

11. This instrument of government comes into effect on 31 August 2015.
12. This instrument was made by order of the Kingston upon Hull Local Authority on 10 July 2015.
13. A copy of the Instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
